Connecting on campus

The wi-fi network at the University of Surrey is called eduroam. Connect your mobile devices to eduroam wi-fi for uninterrupted connectivity between campus and your university accommodation.

eduroam wi-fi is available on all University of Surrey campuses.

To connect to it:

- Make sure you know your IT username and password (confirmed when you registered).
- Check your wi-fi is turned on and your device is not connected to a network cable.
- In the wi-fi settings for your device, select "eduroam" and enter your University
 of Surrey credentials username@surrey.ac.uk (e.g. ab12345@Surrey.ac.uk).
- Some devices will require you to download the 'get eduroam' application from your device's play store.
- In your university accommodation please use the Residents Network (RESNET_WIFI) to connect your games consoles and smart devices.
- For device specific instructions please visit https://it.surrey.ac.uk/connecting-internet

Your device should now be connected to eduroam whenever the service is in range.

Connecting in university accommodation

If you are staying in university accommodation, you will need to use the ResNet service to connect to your smart devices.

Once connected to eduroam, you can connect to ResNet.

If you are using a smart device such as a games console or smart plug, you will need to register your device at: managemydevices.surrey.ac.uk and then connect your smart device to RESNET_WIFI using the generated passkey.

You can also plug in up to three devices using the wired ports on the bottom of the ResNet device. Simply plug in the network cable from your device into one of the wired ports to get connected.

The recommended ethernet cable to use is a 3m Cat5e ethernet cable.
